



SENIOR PROJECT MANAGER – IT INFRASTRUCTURE AND INNOVATION

Talk Suicide is Canada's only national, bilingual, suicide specific helpline. It is available 24/7/365 to those with suicide-related concerns. CAMH is the lead organization for Talk Suicide, working with founding partners Crisis Services Canada and the Canadian Mental Health Association, National, to expand and enhance the service in collaboration with local distress centres across Canada. Recently, CAMH was announced as the lead for the coordination and service delivery planning for 988, a three-digit number for suicide prevention in Canada, which is expected to launch in November 2023.

The Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH) is seeking a Senior Project Manager, IT Infrastructure and Innovation to hold responsibility for the strategic planning, monitoring and implementation of Information Technology and Information Management project activity required for the successful implementation of 988, including necessary advancements in support of Talk Suicide Canada.

Reporting to the Director, 988 Implementation and CAMH's Enterprise Project Management Office, you will be a key point person for the project and be responsible for hands on development of project deliverables.

In this role, your key responsibilities will include:

- Managing a team and working with multiple stakeholders, the project funder, and clinical and executive stakeholders both internal and external to CAMH to ensure effective delivery of Talk Suicide and 988.
- Developing the project approach, plan, and status.
- Leading and participating in working groups and task tables relevant to 988 Implementation.
- Overseeing IT Roadmap to support 988 implementation.
- Supporting options analyses to help determine the best technological approaches for implementing 988.
- Facilitating and leading task teams for the planning and coordination of 988 in Canada.
- Developing and delivering project presentations for various stakeholders both internal and external, including executive audiences.

Successful candidates will demonstrate the following:

- A University degree in Information Technology or related field; Master's Degree in a related field is an asset.
- Demonstrated progressive experience in project management and/or Information Technology with increasing complexity and scope.
- Proven experience successfully managing large-scale IT infrastructure, cloud and telecom



projects.

- Strong organization and planning skills.
- Strong analytical, organizational, conceptual and decision-making skills.
- Procurement experience, including vendor and contract management is an asset.
